Jamie Primrose's vibrant oils of Edinburgh and its environs have ensured his popularity amongst collectors since he started working full-time as an artist in 2003. This latest collection explores a more monochrome palette, working in ink and wash to render the grey winter cityscape of his home town. Drawing on hundreds of photos and a memory of place, Primrose worked up this collection of 40-odd pieces that explore Edinburgh from Marchmont to Stockbridge, via the Grassmarket (pictured). A BA (Fine Art) graduate from Newcastle University in 1994, he works on all his pieces "simultaneously" in the WASPS Studios at Patriohall, at the bottom of Edinburgh's New Town. Those who like Primrose's work but can't afford a large oil – often up to £8000 – will be pleased to note that his striking inks start at a (relatively) more affordable £900.
